Conclusions

- EECARO integrated and rolled out the accelerators and strategic shifts without clear concepts or comprehensive guidance.
- The Regional Programme 2022-2025 does not have a clear strategy for implementing the accelerators and strategic shifts.
- EECARO played a pivotal supportive role in operationalizing the accelerators and strategic shifts to achieve country-level outputs.
- UNFPA's global focus on the transformative results overlooks significant regional priorities and opportunities within the organization's mandate.
- UNFPA's focus on demographic resilience constitutes a critical response to the population ageing and decline megatrend in the EECA region.
- The Regional Programme for 2026-2029 should accord greater prominence to the humanitarian preparedness and response accelerator and strategic shifts.

- Enhance national emergency preparedness and resilience by focusing on environmental scanning and foresight.
- Develop a results-oriented regional strategy to deepen UNFPA's commitment to gender-transformative approaches.
- Formulate a distinct LNOB strategy for the region to serve as a unifying framework for diverse funding sources.
- Develop a region-specific innovation framework encompassing digitalization.

Operational Recommendations

- Formulate a multi-year human resources plan.
- Formulate a plan to implement the UNFPA Knowledge Management Strategy within the EECA region.
