This is with reference to the Standard Administrative Arrangement (SAA) signed between the Government of Luxembourg and UNFPA dated 28 December 2010 relating to a contribution towards the UNICEF/UNFPA Joint Programme to "Accelerate the Abandonment of Female Genital Mutilation/Cutting (FGM/C)".

Section I, para 1 of the said Arrangement confirmed the decision of the Government of Luxembourg to make a contribution of 700,000 Euros and "such further amounts as it may decide (hereinafter referred to as the "Contribution") to support the Programme."

It has been agreed by the Government of Luxembourg to contribute an additional 1.600.000 Euros for 2011-2013 with the following payment schedule:

December 2011:

800.000 Euros

March 2012:

800.000 Euros

It should further be noted that the duration of the Joint Programme was extended to 31 December 2013 based on a decision by the Joint Programme Steering Committee of which Luxembourg is a member on 9 July 2011.

All other terms and conditions stipulated in the SAA dated 28 December 2010 shall continue to apply.

Attached to this letter is also copy of a two-pager summarizing the main thrust of the Joint Programme as well as the current funding gap.
