	In response to a request during the commenting period from the Government of the Republic of Moldova, UNFPA has made the following changes to the CPD to align it with the latest UNSDCF language: (a) paragraph 4 of the narrative; and (b) UNSDCF Outcome 1 in the Results and Resources Framework. The language of these updated sections is shown below:
	 (a) 4. The linkages between sustainable peace and the humanitarian- development nexus need to be addressed by reinforcing integration of the immediate needs of most vulnerable populations and strengthening dialogue and social cohesion, including in relation to the Transnistrian conflict and heightened geopolitical tensions. (b) UNSDCF OUTCOME(S): 1: By 2027, institutions deliver human rights-based, evidence-informed and gender-responsive services for all, with the focus on those who are left behind.
	In addition, a technical correction was made in the Results and Resources Framework. Regarding the UNSDCF outcome indicator "Prevalence of violence against women and girls (aged 15-65) by partner/spouse in the last 12 months by age and form of violence", the baseline for psychological violence as reflected in the UNSDCF is 25.7% not 18%.
