Office management

Leveraging on the implementation of the new country programme (2023-2024), liaise with the Division for Human Resources and the Arab States Regional Office to undertake a human resource alignment exercise and explore options to attract suitable candidates. (country office, high, 2022)

Risk management

With support from the Chief Risk Officer and the ERM Coordinator, timely perform a more rigorous risk assessment, starting with the assignment of risk ratings commensurate with the risk profile of the assessed areas, and develop, implement, and report on action plans to mitigate 'critical' and 'high' risks through the corporate UNFPA ERM application. Programme supplies management

- With support from the Latin America and the Caribbean Regional Office, the Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights Branch (previously known as Commodity Security Branch) and the Supply Chain management Unit, work with relevant stakeholders (Government and development partners) to secure additional resources covering the cost of licenses, training and maintenance to widely extend the use of an effective national Logistics Management Information System (LMIS).
