Ethical Awareness & Decision-Making

- 3,130 attended live training = 69% of the total workforce
- Attendance up 163% since 2019
- 92% said they learned something new
- 95% said they identified practical applications for ethics in their workplace
- 97% said the training was a worthwhile use of their time
- 74% of personnel completed the mandatory online ethics training course



Online Engagement

- Up 372% since 2019 = 337,000 hours spent viewing ethics content
- 32,100 views of Ethics intranet page &2,292 viewing hours in 2022
- 5,090 views of Ethics YouTube channel
- 15 online micro courses
- Visits to 3 country offices



Advice & Guidance

- 44% increase in requests since 2022
- 18% less in 2022 vs. 2021
- 2022 strategy: resolve low-risk transactional queries with self-guided content online



Retaliation

9 Formal requests for protection in 2022


- 3: investigated & retaliation established

- Identified & resolved 167 potential conflicts of interest concerns.
- No notable conflicts of interest identified upon review or third-party verification
- Revision of the Financial Disclosure Policy
