This critical role ensures the effective coordination, prioritization, and delivery of essential services to protect women and girls in humanitarian settings. These services include life-saving interventions such as case management, the establishment of safe spaces, and the provision of mental health and psychosocial support for women, girls, and survivors of gender-based violence.
