A long-term partner with a lasting impact

The UK has been a leading donor to UNFPA for many years. This investment supports the UK's commitment to advancing the rights and choices of women and girls worldwide. The UK has been an indispensable partner in programmes aimed at ending child marriage and eliminating harmful practices, such as female genital mutilation, so girls can continue their education and realize their full potential.

Provider of life-saving supplies

In 2024, the UK maintained its position as the top donor to the UNFPA Supplies Partnership, which provides critical maternal health medicines in many of the world's lowest-income countries. Between 2008 and 2020, the programme is estimated to have prevented 89 million unintended pregnancies, 1.6 million child deaths, and 254,000 maternal deaths.
