Ensuring equitable access to sexual and reproductive health and rights

France and UNFPA share a strong partnership aimed at advancing global reproductive health and rights. France actively collaborates with UNFPA on various initiatives, such as eliminating gender-based violence, promoting comprehensive sexuality education, and improving access to quality health-care services for women and young people.

A partner to deliver reproductive health supplies

France is one of UNFPA's most steadfast supporters of the UNFPA Supplies Partnership, which strengthens health systems through improving supply chains, advancing policy, diversifying financing and expanding access to a range of quality-assured contraceptives and maternal health medicines. The UNFPA Supplies Partnership is a key driver of the Generation Equality Forum's Action Coalition on Bodily Autonomy's goal to reach adolescent girls and women with access to family planning. Between 2021 and 2025, France is committing 90 million Euro to the programme.

A new humanitarian partnership

In recent years, France has actively participated in UNFPA's humanitarian efforts, supporting emergency responses that address the unique needs of women and girls in crisis situations, including in Iraq, Ukraine and other countries.
